More fish are caught from Ludington than any other Michigan port. The season kicks off in April with the arrival of big Brown Trout in shallow, inshore water. May means early season King and Chinook Salmon. June brings big catches of Lake Trout. Come July and August big, battling Steelhead, King and Coho Salmon are at their peak. These are Lake Michigan trophy months. Captain Mike Gnatkowski tells us that charter fishing is no longer just for guys. In fact, this year, women will be fishing against the guys in the Gander Mountain Offshore Classic.
